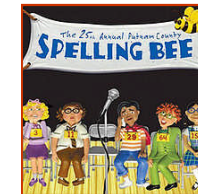


25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee

Musical comedy about contestants in a spelling bee. Tells the story of the contestants lives through song and flash backs during the hilarious spelling bee!

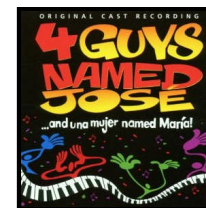


4 Guys Named Jose and Una Mujer Named Maria!

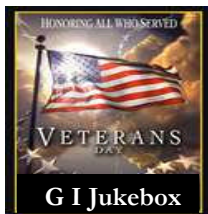
